About Under the Dog:

Under the Dog is the biggest budgeted Japanese anime project to date in the animation category of Kickstarter. It is also one of the first Japanese anime projects ever launched to be solely funded by a crowd funding. Top creative talents have gathered to work on this high-profile project, including Jiro Ishii (“428: In a Blockaded Shibuya”, “Canaan”, “Nine Hours, Nine Persons, Nine Doors” and “Imabikiso”) as the original storywriter, Masahiro Ando (“Sword of the Stranger”, “Canaan”, “Hanasaku Iroha”, and “Blast of Tempest”) as the director, and Yusuke Kozaki (“No More Heroes” and “Fire Emblem: Awakening”) as the character designer.
