Asked about any potential comms for accessibility page - Tobias advised that will be done this week Hard goal to have an accessibility coord? Alyx advised we've had no one volunteer for this role but it is a priority.

Elevators brought up as being a problem in Summit, length of time extensive - Anna has advised that none of the elevators should be closed unless they are non-operational - if there are issues please alert

Ongoing conversation about how to prioritize folks for the elevator use with SCC staff - Mitch also working on this

Asked about badge name changes, Anna advised to visit process page on the registration FAQs Always email info@ and/or chair@ if you have any issues with discrimination or a negative experience with staff.

Asked if we have a general staff handbook, Anna advised we do not but it is on the list of to-dos with Chair

Volunteer/ADA - attendee raised concern about a lack of mandatory staff training

When is the first meeting after con and volunteer sign up for 2026? Anna advised early summer 2025. Meetings will be discussed among the board.

Attendee asked about a orientation session first day of con - Anna advised that has historically not worked well and was inequitable

Attendee asked about an SOP for volunteering - Alyx informed that some depts have staff that never see attendees. One size fits all general SOP would not make sense for Sakura Con.

Attendee suggested each dept director do an orientation video to disseminate to staff.

Attendee brought up issue of lack of seating in summit specifically, as well as signage for seating, Alyx advised this is controlled by the building, fire marshal and building capacity laws

Anna also advised there are conversations about addtl seating, but that is an ongoing conversation with the fire marshal and Mitch

Accessibility will also depend on the convention layout. I heard that the layout last year between the two buildings made it difficult to navigate, have any changes been made to make it easier on those with accessibility needs? Such as aisle sizes or separation of panels and events between the two buildings? Advised that Aisle sizes are between 13-20 feet in Exhibits and Artist Alley

Attendee brought up that staff in the past hasn't been aware of where first aid is - Alyx advised if there is an emergency, a Green Coat (SCC staff) should be alerted
